<b>MIDDLE SCHOOL</b>	<p><b>Reading:</b> 15 minutes of reading x 4 nights a week <b>Maths:</b> 500 points on Mathletics <a href="#">Optional: Maths Masters</a></p> <p>*Focus on students completing tasks and recognising their efforts</p>
<b>SENIOR SCHOOL</b>	<p><b>Reading:</b> 20 minutes of reading per night x 4 nights a week <b>Maths:</b> 750 points on Mathletics <a href="#">Optional: Maths Masters</a></p> <p><b>Grade 6 only</b> <b>Speaking and Listening:</b> Speech Club preparation</p> <p>*Focus on students completing tasks and recognising their efforts *Grade 6 students will attend homework club if they have not completed the work</p>
